- Bully, harass or intimidate any individual or organization
- Are unlawful, libelous, defamatory, abusive, threatening, harmful, obscene, profane, sexually orientated or racially offensive
- Infringe or violate someone else's rights
- Discuss ongoing legal proceedings
- Are spam
- Advertise products or services
- Are irrelevant or off-topic
- Are disruptive
- Are repetitive
