Trevor Stansfield 12 November 1931 - 5 January 2018



Former Billericay Town Councillor Trevor Stansfield died on 5th January aged 86. He was one of the original Councillors when the Town Council was first set up in May 1997 and became its second Chairman in May 1999. Trevor continued as Chairman of the Council until May 2006, he retired from the Council in May 2016. Apart from the Town Council Trevor was very active in the Community. He was a Governor of Mayflower School, past Chairman of the Residents Association and editor of The Resident as well as past Chairman of the Twinning Association. He also found time to be a member of the Rotary Club of Billericay. Trevor did not grow up in Billericay, he moved to the Town with his late wife 50 years ago, but he loved the Town and was committed to the local community. He will be sadly missed by many in Billericay.

Mik Dunn 31 March 1932 - 15 December 2017



Billericay Town Councillor Jack Michael Dunn, better known to everyone as Mik, died on 15th December aged 85. Mik served on the Town Council for four and a half years from December 2005 until May 2010. Mik was a valuable member of the Planning Committee and also a former Vice Chairman of the Finance and General Purposes Committee. He also served on a number of working parties and project groups, most notable of which was the community wide group which produced the Billericay Design Statement which was incorporated into Basildon Council's Planning Guidance. Mik stood down from the Council in May 2010 but continued to take part in one of our events that was close to his heart, the annual Litter Pick. Mik took part for the last time 2 years ago and he will be sadly missed this year.
