a) Further to minute 127 from H,W & Env 24th November members to receive and consider quotations for the Mayflower statue plinth sign **(herewith)**

b) To consider the following proposals from Cllr Tutton:

(i) that the statue is lit at night so it remains on full view 24 hours a day, as at the moment it currently blends into the wall behind it when the light goes. Members are reminded that to get the War Memorial lit via a lamp column in 2018 the cost was £1,495 for the connection by an ECC approved contractor, the lights and fittings were provided free by local company RSE Building Supplies.

(ii) that a request is made to the owner of the building behind the statue that the Town Council be permitted to paint the wall in a light colour so as to make the statue stand out.

c) To consider a request from the Billericay Tree Wardens that 2x "Pilgrim 400 Apple Tree" cultivars are planted in Jim Shields garden. The cost would be approx. £99 for the trees with an additional £35 for grit/rootgrow/compost. The Wardens have the facility to water the trees on a regular basis should there be another dry spring.
