7. Outwood Common Play Area

Members to receive and consider notes from a preliminary meeting which took place with local residents on 12th January 2022. A further meeting is scheduled to take place on 16th March 2022.

8. Skatepark

Further to minute 73 from H,W & Env 4.1.22 members to receive and consider the following:

Quotations to remove the half pipe:

(a) Basildon Borough Council - £2,400

(b) Radium Ramps - £1,250

Radium Ramps also quoted £3,000 for repairs to the ramp but felt this was not the recommended option as the ramp is in very poor condition and any repairs would not be cost effective. A new same sized galvanised steel half pipe on the site would cost around £14,000. Resurfacing would be required every 8-10 years and this would be a nice complimentary piece to a modern concrete skatepark.

Basildon Council also quoted for removal of the old skatepark hardstanding at a cost of £13,765. Members to consider whether this is something the Town Council should look at doing after Basildon has installed the new skatepark.

9. Defibrillator Register

A resident contacted the Town Clerk to make councillors aware they had recently called the ambulance service and been given the incorrect code to their nearest defibrillator. Members to consider whether the Town Council should collate a database of all defibrillators located within the town boundary to ascertain who owns them and who is responsible for their maintenance.

10. Flagpole at Police Station

The Town Council's flag broke off in a storm and the flagpole is now unusable. Essex Police are responsible for maintenance however it is unlikely they will effect repairs. BBC Planning say flagpoles can be erected at the Chantry Centre under permitted development so it is proposed that this item goes to Finance and General Purposes for further consideration.

11. Litter Bin at Railway Station

It has been notified to the Town Council that a bin provided by BTC has a rusty inner with a hole in which needs to be replaced. There are two BTC bins at the station, both of which are in poor condition therefore it is proposed that the Council replaces them **(see attached photograph)**
